তদন্ত কমিটি গঠন কৰা হৈছে আৰু উক্ত কমিটিয়ে বিষয়টোৰ ওপৰত তদন্ত কৰি আছে। তদুপৰি এই ক্ষেত্ৰত বিহিত ব্যৱস্থা গ্ৰহণৰ বাবে কৰ্মচাৰী (পাৰ্চনেল) বিভাগক জনোৱা হৈছে। পত্ৰৰ প্ৰতিলিপি 'পৰিশিষ্ট-গ' ত সংলগ্ন কৰা হ'ল।

নিগমৰ বিভিন্ন বিস্তীৰ্ণ খেলিমেলিৰ তদন্ত তথা দোষী কৰ্মচাৰীৰ বিহিত ব্যৱস্থাৰ বাবে ইতিমধ্যে দিচপুৰ থানাত FIR দাখিল কৰা হৈছে। FIR ৰ প্ৰতিলিপি 'পৰিশিষ্ট-ঘ' ত সংলগ্ন কৰা হ'ল।

মীন উন্নয়ন নিগমত পি. কে. হাজৰিকা নামৰ বিষয়াজনে পূৰ্বতে মীন উন্নয়ন বিষয়াৰ পৰিবৰ্তে অ.এচ.ডি. পদবীতহে কাৰ্যনিৰ্বাহ কৰি আছিল। পি. কে. হাজৰিকা, অ.এচ.ডি. সম্পৰ্কত কোনো অভিযোগ মাননীয় বিধায়ক শ্ৰী দেৱব্ৰত শইকীয়াৰ পৰা মীন বিভাগে পোৱা নাই। ইতিমধ্যে, পি. কে. হাজৰিকা, অ.এচ.ডি.ক যোৱা ৩১-১২-২০২১ তাৰিখৰ পৰা নিগমৰ সেৱাৰ পৰা অব্যাহতি দিয়া হৈছে।

(জ) কৰিমগঞ্জ জিলা মীন বিষয়াই নাৰীৰ শ্ৰীলতা হানি কৰাৰ বিষয়ে কোনো লিখিত অভিযোগ চৰকাৰে পোৱা নাই, কিন্তু বিভিন্ন প্ৰচাৰ মাধ্যমৰ জৰিয়তে তেওঁৰ অপকৰ্মৰ বিষয়ে প্ৰচাৰ হোৱাত চৰকাৰে বিষয়টো গুৰুত্বসহকাৰে লয় আৰু তেওঁক চৰকাৰী চিঠি নং FISH. 152/ 2021/ 110, dtd. the 17th March, 2022 মৰ্মে জয়সাগৰ, শিৱসাগৰলৈ শাস্তিমূলক বদলিকৰণ কৰা হয়। ইতিমধ্যে, উক্ত বিষয়গৰাকীৰ সন্দৰ্ভত বিভাগীয় প্ৰক্ৰিয়াৰ (Departmental Proceeding) বাবে যাৱতীয় ব্যৱস্থা গ্ৰহণ কৰা হৈছে।





With reference to the subject cited above this FIR is being filed in pursuance of direction given by Joint Secretary, Department of Revenue, Govt. of Assam regarding illegal transfer of money from the account of AFDC to their employees and contractors floating the existing guidelines issued by the Government of Assam.

That from our internal investigation it has brought to our notice regarding unauthorized transfer of money amounting Rs.7,14,15,723/- (seven crore fourteen lakhs fifteen thousand seven hundred twenty three) to individual Savings Accounts of the employees of AFDC Ltd. including contractors whereas details provided by the accounts section are annexed herewith. The said transfer of money to individual Savings Account as well to various contractors were done without due procedure and money were transferred fraudulently violating the existing procedure provided by the Government.

It is prayed before you kindly to investigate the incident and punish the persons including the conspirators involved with fraudulent transfer of money of the corporation and the corporation will provide all available relevant information required by you for investigation. The said irregularities of transfer of fund were found from the year 2017 to October 2021 which were sanctioned as an advance by AFDC authority.

It is suspected that a large network of persons are involved in the conspiracy to defraud the corporation by way of transferring it to individual Savings Account of the employees of the corporation as well as to various contractors. Therefore It is prayed before you kindly to investigate the incident and punish them as per law including any other persons found involved during the course of investigation.
